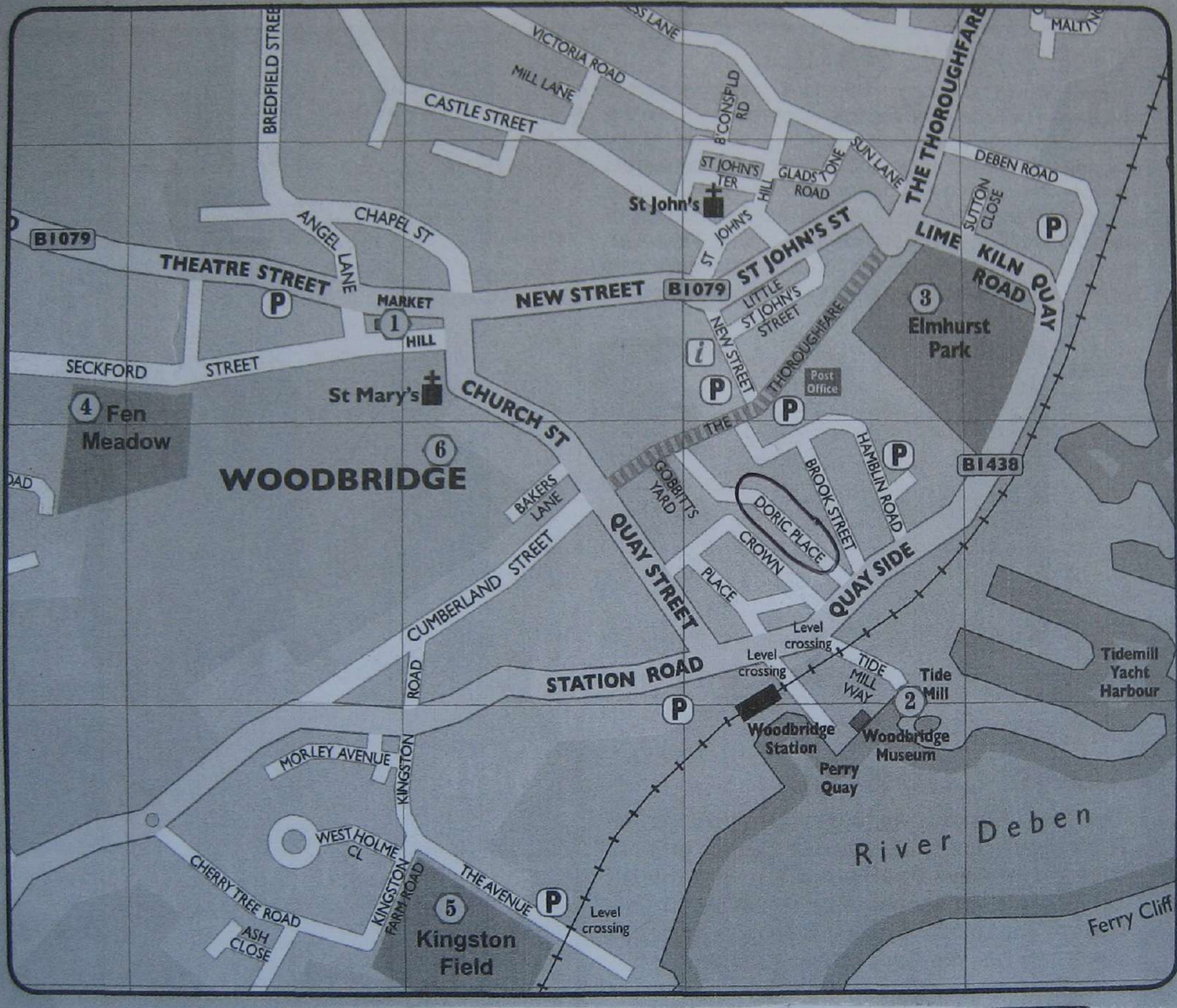
NOTE:

The Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 requires an Applicant for a Modification Order to serve notice of the application on every owner and occupier of any land affected by the claimed route. Where it is not possible to identify the landowner or occupier the Applicant may (on direction of the County Council) address the notice 'to the owner or occupier' and fix it to a post or a conspicuous object on the land. The Applicant must then complete this Schedule 9 Certificate to certify to Suffolk County Council that these requirements have been satisfied.
